

Cookie Policy

Our website uses cookies to distinguish you from other users of our website. This helps us to provide you with a great experience when you browse our website and also allows us to improve our website where required.

A cookie is a small file of letters and numbers that we store on your browser or the hard drive of your computer if you agree. Cookies contain information that is transferred to your computer's hard drive.

We use the following cookies:

- **Strictly necessary cookies.** These are cookies that are required for the operation of our website. These essential cookies are always enabled because our website won't work properly without them. They include, for example, cookies that enable you to log into secure areas of our website, use a shopping cart or make use of e-billing services. You can switch off these cookies in your browser settings but you may then not be able to access all or parts of our website.
- **Analytical or performance cookies.** These allow us to recognise and count the number of visitors and to see how visitors move around our website when they are using it. This helps us to improve the way our website works, for example, by ensuring that users are finding what they are looking for easily.
- **First party cookies.** These are a pattern type cookie set by Google Analytics. They enable us to distinguish unique users by assigning a randomly generated number as a client identifier. They are included in each page of the website to calculate visitor, session and campaign data for the website's analytics report as well as to count and track page views. This helps to enhance the user experience of our website.

You can find more information about the individual cookies we use and the purposes for which we use them in the table below:

<u>Cookie Key</u>	<u>Purpose</u>
_gat_UA-260673737-1	This is a pattern type cookie set by Google Analytics, where the pattern element on the name contains the unique identity number of the account or website it relates to. It is a variation of the _gat cookie which is used to limit the amount of data recorded by Google on high traffic volume websites.
_ga_VSP9RLFLTC	This cookie is used by Google Analytics to persist session state.
_ga	This cookie name is associated with Google Universal Analytics - which is a significant update to Google's more commonly used analytics service. This cookie is used to distinguish unique users by assigning a randomly generated number as a client identifier. It is included in each page request in a site and used to calculate visitor, session and campaign data for the sites analytics reports.
_gid	This cookie is set by Google Analytics. It stores and update a unique value for each page visited and is used to count and track page views.

Third Parties

We do not share the information collected by the cookies with any third parties apart from Own Your Space Limited.

Expiration
